More than 850 million people in the world go hungry, and as many as 35 million of them are Americans! Worldwide, some estimate that 40 million people die each year because of hunger and diseases related to malnutrition -- and many of them are children!

In fact, all of the world's leaders agreed to cut the number of starving people in half by the year 2015, as the first priority of the Millennium Development Goals.

World Food Day (End Hunger Day) was adopted by the UN in 1980 to commemorate the founding of the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations on October 16, 1945. The official goal of the day is to "heighten public awareness of the world food problem and strengthen solidarity in the struggle against hunger, malnutrition and poverty."
